

NOTE FROM THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY REGARDING SIGNING THE
FINAL ACT OF THE HAVANA CONFERENCE BY TURKEY

Turkey was unable to sign the Final Act at the close of the Havana Conference as the Turkish Delegate authorized to sign was not in Havana on the date of signature. Consequently the Turkish Delegation requested permission to sign the Final Act at a later date.

Accordingly on Monday, 26 July 1948, His Excellency, Ambassador Selin Sarper, Permanent Representative of Turkey at the United Nations, signed in New York the Final Act of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Employment.
