NOTES TO THE SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT OF ANTI-DUMPING ACTIONS SUBMITTED BY CANADA For the Period 1 July to 31 December 1993

- 1. The symbol (R) is used if an investigation is opened in the context of a review of an existing anti-dumping measure.
- 2. Provisional measures apply from the date a preliminary determination of dumping is made up to the conclusion of the Canadian International Trade Tribunal's inquiry regarding injury caused to Canadian producers of like goods (maximum 120 days from the preliminary determination date). The percentage represents the estimated margin of dumping of the dumped imports calculated as a percentage of normal value.
- 3. Either the date of a positive injury finding, in a case of an investigation, or the date of the conclusion of a review of normal values and export prices in cases where there is an existing Canadian International Trade Tribunal finding of injury. The percentage represents the estimated margin of dumping of the dumped imports calculated as a percentage of normal value at the time of the injury finding.

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- 4. The word "Renewal" indicates that an existing undertaking was renewed following a review of the injury question; the word "Amendment" indicates that a technical amendment was made to the undertaking, normally to account for changes in the price or terms contained therein.
- 5. The trade volume is based on statistical data for the latest available 12-month period prior to initiation except as follows:
- * 01.01.93 to 30.06.93 (Corrosion Resistant Steel Sheet originating in or exported from Australia, Brazil, France, Germany, Japan, Korea, New Zealand, Spain, Sweden, the United Kingdom and the United States)
- ** 01.01.92 to 31.08.93 (12 Gauge Shotshells originating in or exported from the Czech Republic, Hungary and Poland)
- *** 01.01.92 to 30.06.92 (Cold-rolled Carbon Steel Sheet originating in or exported from Germany, France, Italy, the United Kingdom and the United States)
- **** 01.01.93 to 31.08.93 (Carbon Steel Plate originating in or exported from Italy, Korea, Spain, and Ukraine)
- ***** 01.01.93 to 30.06.93 (Synthetic Bailer Twine originating in or exported from the Portugal and United States)
- ****** 01.10.91 to 31.12.92 (Fibreglass Pipe originating in or exported from the United States)
- ******* 01.01.92 to 01.09.92 (Copper and Brass Pipe Fittings originating in or exported from the United States)
- ******** 01.01.93 to 30.06.93 (Plastic Shrinkable Bags originating in or exported from the United States)

- 6. On June 18, 1993, Revenue Canada, Customs, Excise and Taxation accepted undertakings from three of the four known exporters of the subject Fibreglass Pipe Insulation. The dumping investigation was suspended at that time. Subsequent to the acceptance of the undertakings, one importer and one exporter requested that Revenue Canada terminate the undertakings. The undertakings were therefore terminated and the investigation was resumed. A preliminary determination of dumping was made on July 22, 1993.
- 7. Revenue Canada, Customs, Excise and Taxation terminated the investigation with respect to Synthetic Bailer Twine originating in or exported from the United States of America on October 27, 1993 due to insufficient evidence of injury. The complainant appealed this decision to the Canadian International Trade Tribunal. The Tribunal advised Revenue Canada that there was, in fact, sufficient evidence of injury to the domestic production of like goods. As a result of the Tribunal's advice, Revenue Canada resumed the investigation and made its preliminary determination of dumping on December 23, 1993.
- 8. Carbon Steel Plate from Yugoslavia involves exports from the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia.

Confidential: information provided to the authorities on a confidential basis or results of a calculation which would disclose information provided on a confidential basis.

Note to the Semi-Annual Reports Submitted by Canada under Article 14:4 of the Agreement

Where an investigation is conducted in the context of a review of an existing anti-dumping measure, the date of completion of the review is shown in column 5, but generally it is not possible to state the margin of dumping in this column. This is because the review procedure was initiated to allow Canadian authorities to determine the current normal value of the imported product, in order to determine, in the future, whether imports of the product are dumped. As the margin of dumping is equal to the difference between the export price and the normal value, it is impossible to determine, a priori, the percentage margin of dumping. In addition, Canadian authorities compile statistical data concerning trade volume of the imported product only when reviewing a determination of injury in the context of possible revocation of the anti-dumping measure. As a result, statistical data on trade volume for columns 11, 12 and 13 are not available for certain investigations of existing anti-dumping measures.
