Explanatory remarks

- 1. The "definitive duty" column has a date indicating either the date of the Tribunal finding or the date of the final determination of dumping.
- 2. The column "Trade Volume" requests statistical data for the latest available calendar year prior to initiation. It should be noted that on occasion, the data provided will not relate to the latest available calendar year since more immediate and pertinent data is available. In the case of certain products, heavy capital equipment for example, it may be appropriate to provide the Trade Volume for more than one calendar year. Accordingly, the criterion for this information column should be the information which formed part of the basis for initiating the investigation.
