#### Explanatory remarks

1. In columns 4, 5, 11 and 12, in some cases data relative to the margin of dumping and the quantity of importations is not provided. For reasons of confidentiality, this information has not been included. Such information can be disclosed where it is determined that such disclosure would not compromise the confidential information of particular companies.
2. Sometimes the "definitive duty" column has a date indicated without an indication of the margin of dumping. The date in question is the date of the Tribunal's findings. The definitive margin of dumping is established subsequent to a finding of material injury.
3. The column "Trade Volume" requests statistical data for the latest available calendar year prior to initiation. It should be noted that on occasion, the data provided will not relate to the latest available calendar year since more immediate and pertinent data is available. In the case of certain products, heavy capital equipment for example, it may be appropriate to provide the Trade Volume for more than one calendar year. Accordingly, the criterion for this information column should be the information which formed part of the basis for initiating the investigation.
