INDIA - LICENSING PROCEDURES WITH RESPECT TO IMPORTS OF ALMONDS

Recourse to Article 4.2 of the Agreement by the United States

Note by the Chairman

1. At its meeting on 29 September 1987, the Committee agreed to establish a Panel to examine the complaint by the United States and authorized the Chairman, in consultation with the parties concerned, to draw up the terms of reference and to designate the Chairman and members of the Panel (LIC/M/19, paragraph 13).

2. The terms of reference of the Panel are as follows:

"To examine, in the light of the relevant provisions of the Agreement on Import Licensing Procedures, the matter referred to the Committee on Import Licensing by the United States relating to India's licensing procedures with respect to imports of almonds (LIC/W/37), and to make such findings as will assist the Committee in making recommendations or rulings as provided for in Article 4 of the Agreement on Import Licensing Procedures."
