#### MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 17 OCTOBER 1990

Chairman: Mr. D. Plunkett

1. The Committee on Import Licensing held its twenty-seventh meeting on 17 October 1990.

2. The agenda for the meeting was contained in GATT/AIR/3008. The Chairman informed the Committee that he intended to add one item to the agenda, which had been omitted by oversight: the Report of the Committee to the CONTRACTING PARTIES. The revised agenda was adopted.

#### A. Status of signatories and observers

3. The Chairman reported that there had been no changes in the status of signatories or observers since the last meeting.

#### B. Information available on Import Licensing Procedures

4. The Chairman reported that since the last meeting publications containing information on import licensing procedures had been received from the New Zealand (LIC/3/Add.26, 27 and 28). New replies to the GATT Import Licensing Questionnaire, issued in the L/5640/- series, had been received from Hungary (Add.12/Rev.1/Suppl.2), Canada (Add.10/Rev.3), Austria (Add.35/Corr.2), Australia (Add.13/Rev.5), South Africa (Add.17/Rev.3/Corr.1), India (Add.7/Rev.4), and Sweden (Add.14/Rev.4).

5. The Committee took note of the information contained in these documents.

#### C. Relationship of the Committee's work to the Uruguay Round

6. The Chairman recalled that, at its meeting on 2 February 1990, the Negotiating Group on MTN Agreements and Arrangements had established an informal group on Import Licensing. This group, which had met six times this year, had produced a negotiating text on improvement of the Agreement, contained in document MTN.GNG/NG8/W/83/Add.1/Rev.2, which was scheduled for discussion on 18 October 1990.
