ARTICLE XAVIII NEGOTIATIONS - 1960

Schedule AVIII - Union of South Africa

On 4 November 1960, the CONTRACTING PARTLES granted the Union of South Africa an extension of time, until 30 November 1960 for the notification of items for renegotiation under Article ANVIII during the current Tariff Conference.

The following items should be added to the list of items already notified for renegotiation under the procedures of paragraph 1 of Article XXVIII and circulated under cover of document SECRET/128 of 7 September 1960:

PART I

Import statistics are not separately recorded for formulated D.D.T. products covered by these two sub-items of the tariff which include many other substances for the prevention or destruction of agricultural and other pests. Based on a recent investigation made in the Union of South Africa it is estimated that the combined imports of formulated D.D.T. products under both sub-items do not exceed 150 short tons per year.
