Notification by the United States of America  
under Article XXVIII

The Government of the United States of America wishes to modify the following concessions<sup>1</sup> pursuant to paragraphs 1 to 3 of Article XXVIII of the General Agreement:

NOTE: The United States reserves the right to increase the ad valorem part of the rate applicable to any of the fabrics provided for in item 1108 or 1109(a) of this Part to 45 per centum ad valorem on any of such fabrics which are entered in any calendar year in excess of an aggregate quantity by weight of 5 per centum of the average annual production of similar fabrics in the United States during the 3 immediately preceding calendar years.

<sup>1</sup>The re-negotiation for the modification of these concessions has been commenced pursuant to paragraph 4 of Article XXVIII (SECRET/108). Since this re-negotiation has not yet been completed the concessions are now being notified with a view to continuing the re-negotiation pursuant to paragraphs 1 to 3 of that Article. As in the re-negotiation under paragraph 4, the United States will continue to recognize Benelux, France, Japan, and Italy as having a substantial supplying interest in the concessions in items 1108 and 1109(a) in Part I of Schedule XX - Geneva 1947.
