Part II - The enumeration of tariff items which are excepted from the exemption from payment of the 20 percent surtax of duty referred to in General Note IV is amended as follows:

After ll-C insert ll-G; change $36-C$ to read $36 m$; and after 260-B insert 308-D.

The enumeration of tariff items in the last sentence of the first paragraph of General Note V is amended by inserting "225-C" after "211-D".

1 This item has been modified by the creation of a new Sub-item (95-J) for sulphate of aluminum; and by eliminating the words "not above 97\% pure" after potassium.
