Pursuant to the decision of the Textiles Committee, taken at its meeting of December 1974 regarding notification to the Textiles Surveillance Body of agreements concluded or actions taken by countries participating in the Arrangement vis-a-vis non-participants, I am instructed by my government to notify the TSB of the amendment of the "Interim Agreement" between the United States and the Republic of China (notified to the TSB as TEX.SB/292).

The "Interim Agreement" has been extended through June 30, 1978 and aggregate, group and specific category limits have been adjusted pro-rata for the three months extension.

Attached hereto is a copy of Department of State Press Release No. 146 of April 5, 1978 setting forth the texts of the note exchange giving effect to the amendments.

UNITED STATES AND THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA AMEND INTERIM AGREEMENT

The United States and the Republic of China exchanged notes on March 30, 1978 to amend the existing Interim Agreement between the two countries. The texts of the notes follow:

### UNITED STATES NOTE

March 30, 1978

His Excellency James C. H. Shen Chinese Ambassador

#### Excellency:

I have the honor to refer to the Interim Agreement of December 16, 1977 (the "Interim Agreement") between the Government of the Republic of China and the Government of the United States of America concerning trade in cotton, wool and man-made fiber textiles and textile products manufactured in the Republic of China.

I have also the honor to refer to discussions between representatives of the Government of the Republic of China and the Government of the United States of America held in Taipei from January 23 to 28, 1978, and in Washington from Pebruary 21 to 24, 1978, concerning exports to the United States of such textiles and textile products. As a result of these discussions I have the honor to propose, on behalf of the Government of the United States of America, that the Interim Agreement be amended as follows:

- 1. Paragraph 1 of the Interim Agreement is amended to read:
- "1. The term of this Interim Agreement shall be from January 1, 1978 through June 30, 1978."
- Paragraph 5 of the Interim Agreement is amended to read:

EB - Mr. C. Hand (202) 632-1682

"5. Categories not subject to Specific Limits are subject to consultation levels and to the Aggregate and applicable Group Limits. Except as specified in Annex C, which sets out certain different consultation levels, consultation levels for categories not subject to Specific Limits shall be 500,000 square yards equivalent for categories in Group I, 350,000 square yards equivalent for categories in Group II, and 50,000 square yards equivalent for categories in Group III."

3. Annexes B and C to the Interim Agreement are deleted and are replaced, respectively, by Annexes B and C to this Note.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to your Government, this note and your Excellency's note of acceptance on behalf of the Government of the Republic of China shall constitute an agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Republic of China, amending the Interim Agreement.
