Dear Mr. Chairman:

Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 4 of Article 4 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles, I am instructed by my government to inform the Textiles Surveillance Body of the further amendment of the wool and man-made fiber textiles agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Socialist Republic of Romania. The original bilateral agreement and prior amendments have been notified and circulated as COM.TEX/SB/267, 294, 347, and as part of 397.

This latest amendment changes category 410 (woolen and worsted fabric) from a minimum consultation level (100,000 square yards equivalent - SYE) to a designated consultation level at 150,000 SYE.

Attached hereto are copies of the letters giving effect to this amendment.

Dear Mr. Fodor:

I refer to the Agreement between the United States of America and the Socialist Republic of Romania Relating to Trade in Wool and Man-Made Fiber Textiles, effected by exchange of notes dated June 17, 1977, as amended (the Agreement), and to consultations held in Washington on July 18, 1979 between representatives of the Government of Romania and representatives of the Government of the United States.

As a result of the request made in your letter of June 18, 1979 and in accordance with the results of the abovementioned consultations, I propose that paragraph 3(C) of the Agreement be amended to establish a designated consultation level of 150,000 square yards equivalent for category 410, woolen and worsted fabric.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Socialist Republic of Romania, this letter and your letter of confirmation on behalf of the Government of the Socialist Republic of Romania shall constitute an amendment to the Agreement, effective on the date of your letter of confirmation.
