In connection with the European Economic Community's Agreement on trade in textile products with the Philippines negotiated under Article 4 of the Arrangement and initialled on 31 December 1977, I have to inform you of the following:

During the course of 1979 imports of babies'knit outerwear, (Cat. (71) and babies' woven garments, (Cat. 80) from the Philippines into the United Kingdom and Ireland regions of the Community exceeded 11 Trand 0.5 T (Cat 71) and 12 T and 5 T (Cat 80) respectively, being the Levels at which the Community can ask for consultations with a view to establishing a limit in respect of the regions of the Community concerned under the provisions of Article 6 of the Agreement. The Community having deemed that there was real risk of market disruption in these cases, the two sides consulted on 17-18 December 1979 in pursuance of Article 12 of the Agreement. As a result of these consultations, and in conformity with the provisions of the Agreement, the Philippines agreed to limit exports to the United Kingdom and Ireland as follows:

ACREED MINUTE

- 1. Delegations of the Republic of the Philippines and of the European Economic Community met, on 17 and 18 December 1979 in Brussels for consultations in accordance with Article 6 of the Agreement on trade in textiles between the Philippines and the Community initialled on 31. December 1977.
- 2. As a result of these consultations, the Philippines agreed to limit its exports of babies' knitted outer garments (Cat. 71, Nimexe positions 60.05-06; 07; 08; 09) and babies woven garments (Cat. 80, Nimexe positions 61.02-01; 03; and 61.04-01; 09) to the United Kingdom and Ireland. The following restraint levels were agreed:

3. It is the understanding of both parties, that the provisions of the Agreement which concern exports of products subject to quantitative limits established in Annex II, in particular the licence procedures set out in Protocol A, shall apply to exports of babies' knitted outer garments and to babies' woven garments from the Philippines to the United Kingdom and Ireland as from 20 November 1979.
