BRUCELLOSIS STATUS

Communication from Colombia

The following communication, dated 3 January 2011, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of <u>Colombia</u>.

1. The Government of Colombia, through the Colombian Agricultural Institute (ICA) and in conjunction with trade associations and livestock breeders, is implementing the National Brucellosis Eradication Plan.

- 2. Article 11.3.2, Chapter 11.3, of the Terrestrial Animal Health Code of the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE) establishes the requirements for a country or a zone to qualify as free from bovine brucellosis.
- 3. The Cañón de Anaime in the municipality of Cajamarca (department of Tolima) satisfies the health requirements established by the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE) for certification as a zone free from brucellosis, given that all of its livestock has been certified as free from brucellosis.
- 4. Pursuant to Colombian Agricultural Institute (ICA) Resolution No. 4422 of 22 December 2010, the Cañón de Anaime in the municipality of Cajamarca, department of Tolima, was declared a zone free from brucellosis.
