Addendum

The following communication, received on 12 October 2023, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Japan</u>.

- 1. In this communication, Japan would like to provide its counterargument in response to Macao, China's notification <u>G/SPS/N/MAC/27</u> dated 29 September 2023, as a further update to Japan's notification <u>G/SPS/GEN/1233/Rev.6/Add.2</u>, dated 27 September 2023.
- 2. Japan expresses its regret concerning Macao, China's notification <u>G/SPS/N/MAC/27</u>, in which Macao, China notified an import suspension of a range of foodstuffs, including fishery products, originating from ten metropolis/prefectures in Japan, and urges Macao, China to immediately repeal its measures. As Japan's counterargument to notifications concerning import suspension/prohibition by China and Hong Kong, China in its previous communications <u>G/SPS/GEN/1233/Rev.6/Add.1</u> and <u>G/SPS/GEN/1233/Rev.6/Add.2</u> also applies to the notification by Macao, China, Japan does not intend to repeat the same counterargument in this communication.
- 3. As explained in its previous communications <u>G/SPS/GEN/1233/Rev.6/Add.1</u> and <u>G/SPS/GEN/1233/Rev.6/Add.2</u>, Japan remains committed to providing any further explanation required and to having science-based discussions to dispel any concerns or misunderstandings with regard to the safety of the ALPS treated water discharge. Japan is also committed to providing assurance that there are no grounds for Macao, China to maintain their measures.
