UPDATED LIST OF SPECIFIC TRADE CONCERNS RAISED IN THE WTO SPS COMMITTEE

COMMUNICATION FROM THE EUROPEAN UNION

The following communication, received on 2 October 2013, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the <u>European Union</u>.

- 1. The European Union would like to update all WTO Members regarding the status of a number of specific trade concerns previously raised by the European Union in the WTO SPS Committee.
- 2. The concerns listed in the table below are no longer considered by the European Union as barriers to trade. The European Union warmly congratulates its trading partners on their cooperation which allowed these issues to be resolved.
- 3. The European Union would like to encourage all WTO Members to update the list of specific trade concerns previously raised in the WTO SPS Committee, reporting on those issues that can now be considered resolved.
