DECLARATION OF THE CENTRAL-WESTERN REGION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF COATEPEC HARINAS IN THE STATE OF MEXICO AS AN AREA FREE FROM FRUIT FLIES OF THE QUARANTINE-SIGNIFICANT GENUS ANASTREPHA

COMMUNICATION FROM MEXICO

The following communication, dated 2 September 2016, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of <u>Mexico</u>.

- 1. Pursuant to Article 7 of the Agreement on the Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures and paragraph 3(b) of Annex B thereto, Mexico hereby advises WTO Members that the Decision declaring the central-western region of the municipality of Coatepec Harinas in the State of Mexico to be an area free from fruit flies of the quarantine-significant genus *Anastrepha* was published in the Mexican Official Journal on 30 August 2016.
- 2. The notified Decision declares the central-western region of the municipality of Coatepec Harinas in the State of Mexico to be an area free from fruit flies of the quarantine-significant genus *Anastrepha*.
