## PHYTOSANITARY CERTIFICATE FOR EXPORT, PHYTOSANITARY CERTIFICATE FOR RE-EXPORT AND ATTACHMENTS

## COMMUNICATION FROM NICARAGUA

The following communication, dated 31 January 2018, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of <u>Nicaragua</u>.

- 1. The Institute for Agricultural and Livestock Protection and Health (IPSA), established by Law No. 862 creating the Institute for Agricultural and Livestock Protection and Health, published in Official Journal *La Gaceta* No. 91 of 20 May 2014, hereby advises that it will be issuing phytosanitary certificates for re-export and export and re-export certificate attachments, if necessary, in line with the recommendations set forth in International Standard for Phytosanitary Measures (ISPM) No. 12.
- 2. Phytosanitary certificates for re-export and relevant attachments will enter into force on 15 February 2018.
