COMMUNICATION FROM CHILE

Addendum

The following communication, received on 16 November 2022, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of $\underline{\text{Chile}}$.

- ${\bf 1.} \ \ {\bf The \ Agriculture \ and \ Livestock \ Service \ of \ Chile \ (SAG) \ hereby \ advises \ that:$
 - On 24 October 2022, SAG repealed the provisions set out in point 6 of document $\underline{\text{G/SPS/GEN/1770}}$ of 2 April 2020, which established facilities for the submission of original phytosanitary certificates in order to export to Chile, in response to the disruption caused by the COVID-19 virus.
- 2. The above-mentioned decision has been made due to the return to normality seen worldwide and the fact that airlines and courier services are operating without any issues.
- 3. This information was shared with IPPC contact points on 25 October 2022.
- 4. Lastly, Chile states that this communication is being made for the purposes of transparency, without prejudice to the country's rights and obligations under the SPS Agreement.
