Revision

- 1. At its November 2021 meeting, the SPS Committee agreed that the SPS thematic workshop to be held in June 2022 would focus on transparency. As explained at the March 2022 SPS Committee meetings, the workshop will offer an opportunity to provide further training on the new ePing SPS&TBT Platform that went live on 28 March 2022. Members were also invited to share their experiences on the use of the outreach/communication functionalities.
- 2. By way of background, the new Platform integrates all SPS and TBT transparency tools, as well as the ePing alert system, into a single platform. It includes various functions related to notifications, specific trade concerns (STCs), and information exchange, and is available for use by both Members and the broader public, including the private sector. In particular, users can register to receive email alerts on notifications of products and/or markets of interest and reach out to notification authorities and enquiry point officials. The Platform allows officials with additional rights to submit SPS (and TBT) notifications to the WTO.
- 3. The draft programme was circulated on 8 April 2022. Members were invited to submit comments on that programme and suggest speakers. The Secretariat is circulating this final version of the programme in advance of the workshop.
- 4. The workshop will be held in Geneva, Switzerland, on Monday, 20 June 2022, beginning at $\underline{10:00}$ (CET). The workshop can be attended in person or virtually (via Zoom, please register through the \underline{link}).
- 5. In addition, a "notifications clinic" will be held virtually at <u>15:00</u> (CET) (via Zoom, please register through the <u>link</u>), and will afford SPS notification authorities and enquiry points the possibility to address any concerns on the use of the notification submission functionalities of the new ePing SPS&TBT Platform, in direct consultation with the Secretariat.
- 6. Interpretation will be provided in English, French, and Spanish for both the workshop and the "notifications clinic".
