COMMUNICATION FROM CHILE

The following communication, received on 7 June 2022, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of <u>Chile</u>.

1. This communication is to announce that the National Fisheries and Aquaculture Service (SERNAPESCA) of the Ministry of the Economy, Development and Tourism of the Republic of Chile will be modifying the final page of certificates issued digitally or online so that it includes new text:





2. However, certificates that are also issued with an electronic signature will have the following elements:

URL that will link to the SERNAPESCA website. It should be noted that the procedure for verifying online certificates remains unchanged.
