**SPECIFIC TRADE CONCERNS**

Note by the Secretariat<sup>1</sup>

Revision

**I. BACKGROUND**

1. At the 15-16 March 2000 meeting of the SPS Committee, the Secretariat was requested to prepare a paper summarizing the specific trade concerns that had been brought to the Committee's attention since 1995.<sup>2</sup> The Secretariat has revised this document annually to include new information provided by Members (G/SPS/GEN/204/Rev.1 to 9). The specific trade concerns in the tenth revision of G/SPS/GEN/204 maintain the previously assigned numbers according to the chronological order of the Committee meetings in which they were first raised. These numbers serve as unique identifiers and are intended to facilitate tracking of individual trade concerns over time. The new trade concerns raised in each Committee meeting are numbered in the order of the alphabetic list of Members maintaining the measures.

2. The seventh revision of G/SPS/GEN/204 is divided into 4 sections:

- Overview and summary graphs and tables (this section)
- Issues considered in 2009 (Addendum 1)
- Issues not considered in 2009 (Addendum 2)
- Issues resolved before 2009 (Addendum 3).

3. This first section (G/SPS/GEN/204/Rev.10) of the document contains summary statistics and graphs for all the trade concerns raised in the SPS Committee between the first regular meeting of 1995 and the last regular meeting of 2009. The trade concerns are categorized as relating to food safety, animal or plant health. This section also includes a summary table which identifies for each specific trade concern according to the assigned number, the Member(s) maintaining the measure, the Member(s) raising the concern, as well as reference to the Addendum in which the issue is described.

4. Addendum 1 (G/SPS/GEN/204/Rev.10/Add.1) of the document contains information regarding all issues which were raised in the SPS Committee in 2009. This includes (1) issues raised for the first time in 2009; (2) issues which were previously raised but on which further discussions or activities occurred during 2009; and (3) issues for which there was no substantive discussion in the Committee during 2009, but where Members reported that a previously raised issue had been resolved, or where substantive action on the issue occurred in another WTO body during 2009 (e.g., establishment of a dispute resolution panel on the issue).

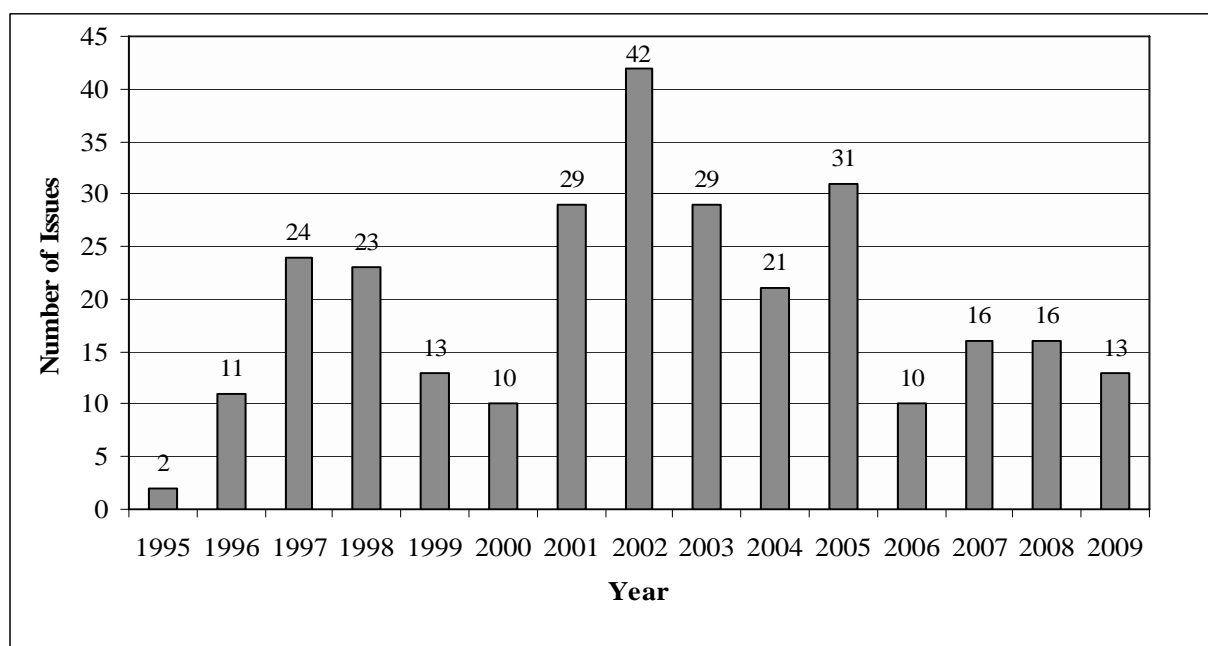
5. Addendum 2 (G/SPS/GEN/204/Rev.10/Add.2) of the document contains information regarding all issues which were raised in the SPS Committee from 1995 through 2008, and on which no further discussion or activities occurred during 2009.

6. Addendum 3 (G/SPS/GEN/204/Rev.10/Add.3) of the document contains information regarding all issues which were raised in the SPS Committee from 1995 through 2008, and on which a resolution was reported prior to 2009.

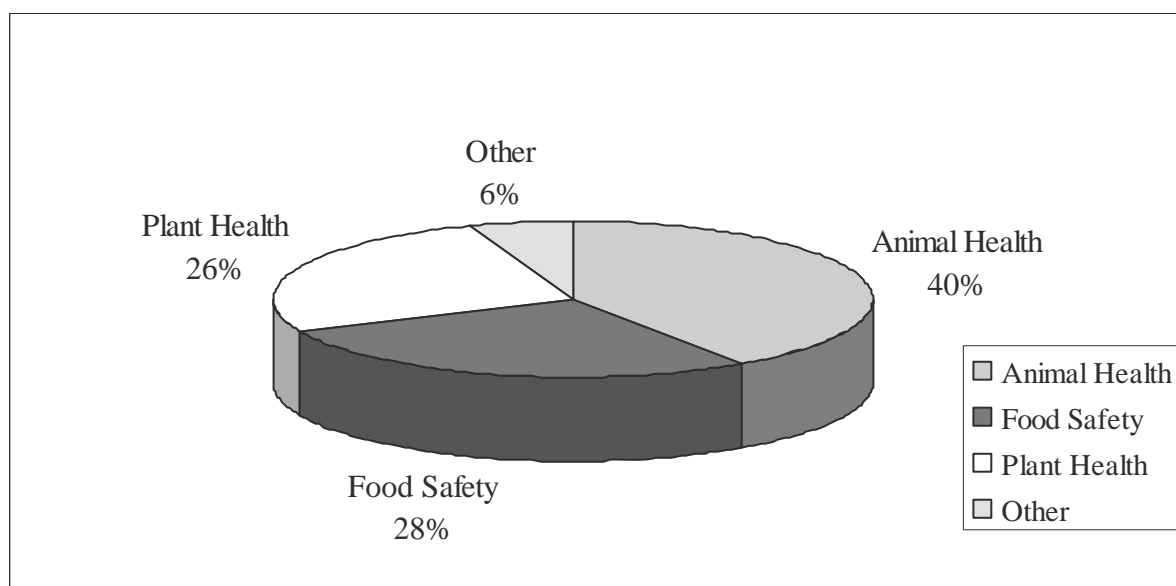
## II. OVERVIEW

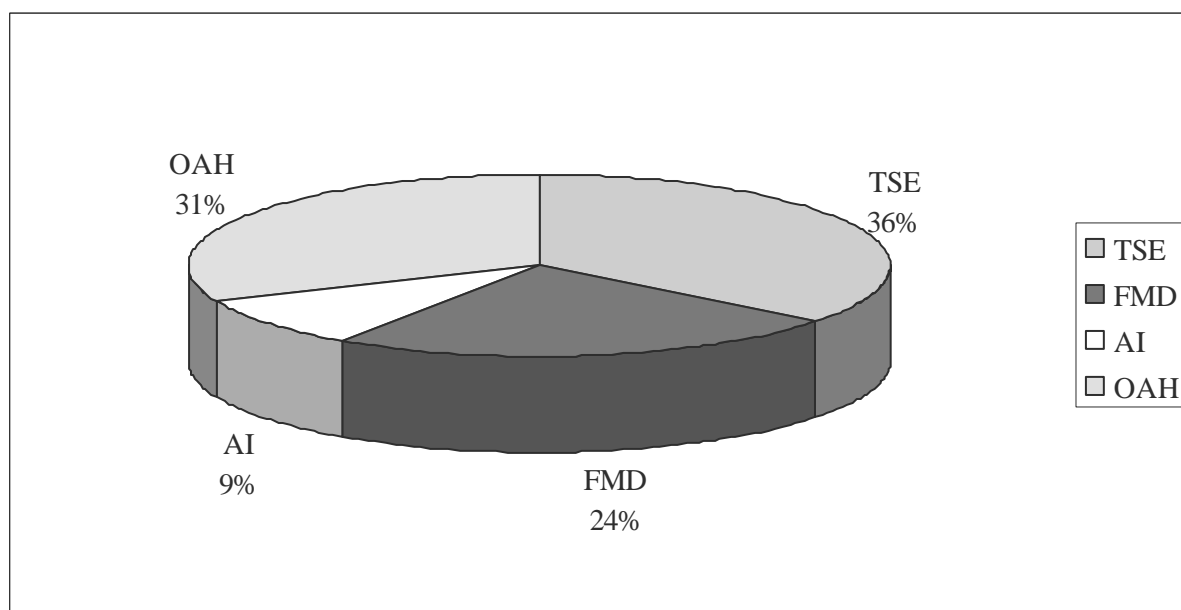
**FIGURE 1 – NUMBER OF NEW ISSUES RAISED**

7. Altogether, 290 specific trade concerns were raised in the fifteen years from 1995 through 2009. Figure 1 shows the number of new concerns raised each year; 13 new concerns were raised in 2009. Figure 2a categorizes the trade concerns raised over the fifteen years into food safety, animal or plant health issues. Overall, 28 per cent of trade concerns relate to food safety concerns, 26 per cent relate to plant health, and 6 per cent concern other issues such as certification requirements or translation. 40 per cent of concerns raised relate to animal health and zoonoses. The animal health and zoonoses category is further divided into foot-and-mouth disease (FMD), transmissible spongiform encephalopathy (TSEs), Avian Influenza (AI) and other animal health concerns (OAH). Figure 2b shows that TSEs account for 36 per cent of animal health concerns, while issues related to foot-and-mouth disease account for 24 per cent. The remaining 40 per cent relate to other animal health concerns and avian influenza.

**FIGURE 2B – TRADE CONCERNS RELATED TO ANIMAL HEALTH & ZOOSES**

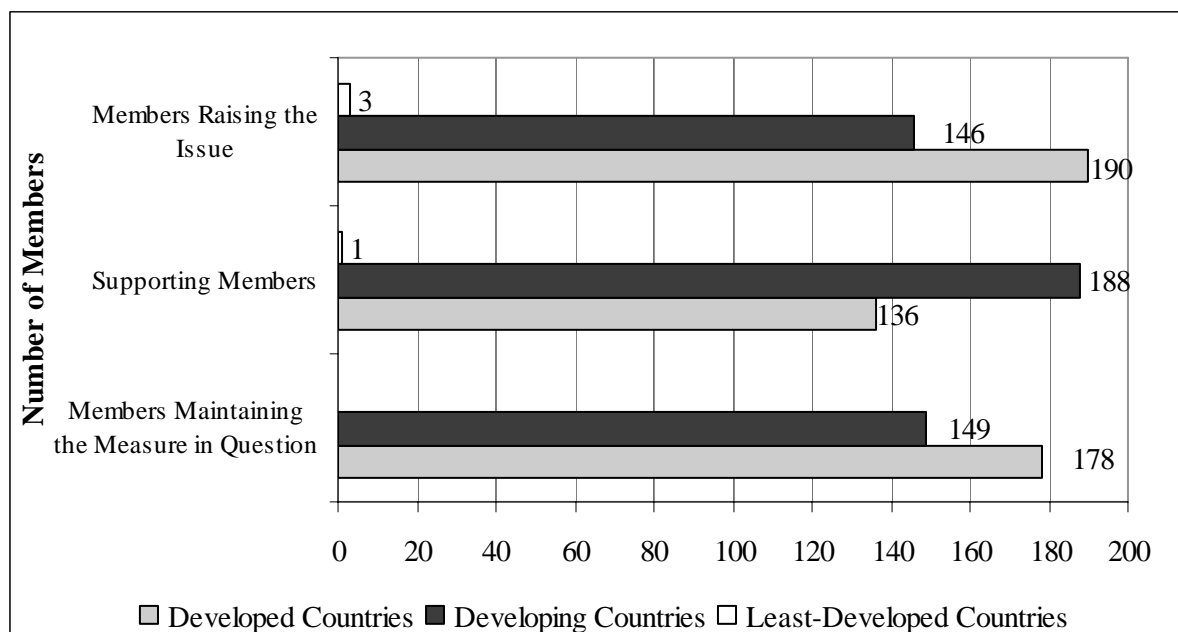


8. Developing countries are participating actively under this agenda item in the SPS Committee meetings. Figure 3a indicates that over the fifteen years, developing country Members have raised 146 trade concerns (on many occasions more than one Member has raised, supported or maintained an issue) compared to 190 raised by developed country Members and three raised by least-developed country Members.<sup>3</sup> A developing country Member has supported another Member raising an issue in 188 cases, compared to 136 for developed country Members and one for least-developed country Members. In 178 cases, the measure at issue was maintained by a developed country Member, and in

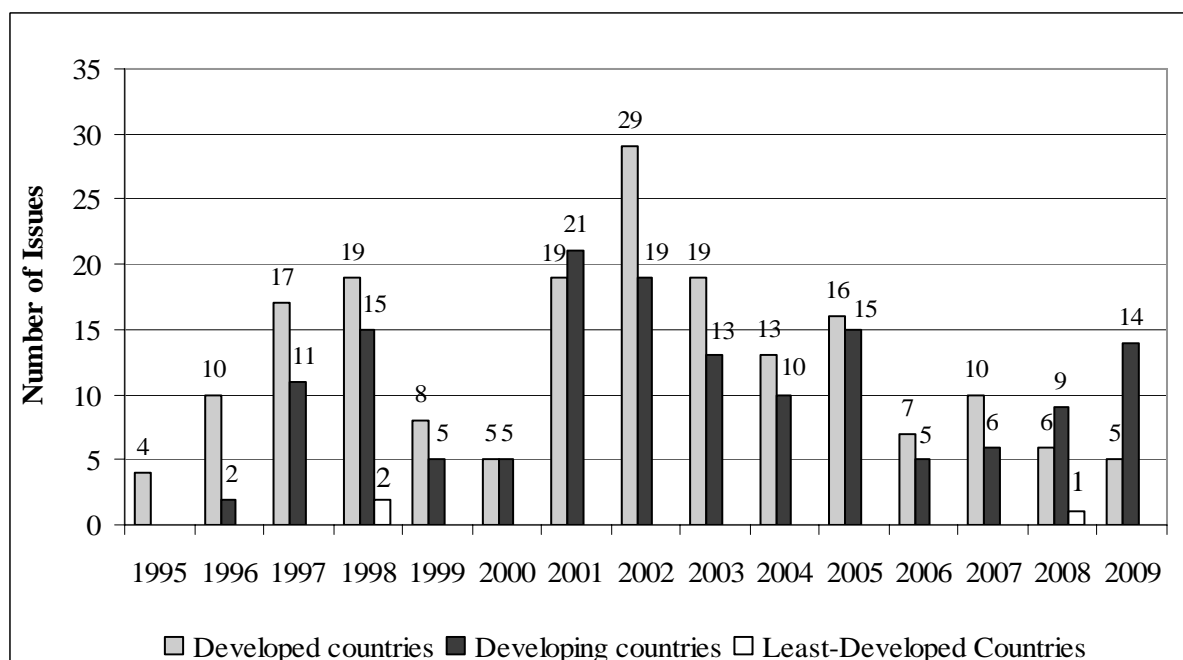

149 cases it was maintained by a developing country Member. No trade concerns regarding measures maintained by least-developed country Members have been raised.<sup>4</sup> Figure 3b shows the number of new issues raised each year by each category of Member.

**FIGURE 3A – PARTICIPATION BY WTO MEMBERS (1995-2009)**



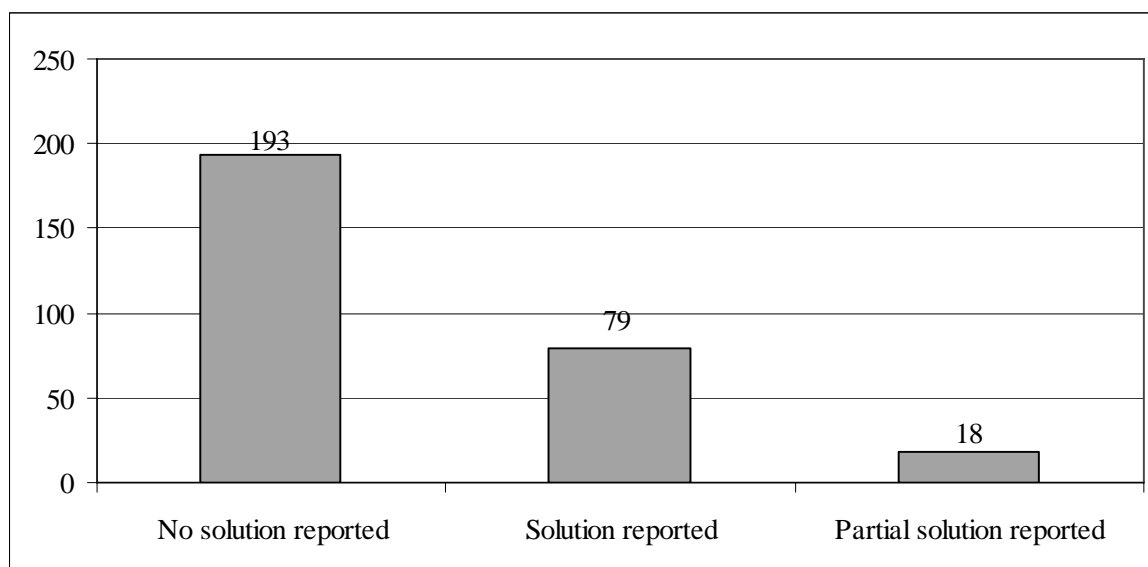
**FIGURE 3B – NUMBER OF NEW ISSUES RAISED BY MEMBERS**

9. Figure 4 indicates that 79 trade concerns have been reported resolved out of the 290 trade concerns raised over the fifteen years. Three issues were reported resolved in 2009. Eighteen trade concerns have been reported partially solved. In these instances, trade may have been allowed for selected products or by some of the importing Members maintaining the measure in question. No solutions have been reported for the remaining 193 trade concerns. Excluding the 13 new issues raised in 2009, there are 180 trade concerns that are at least one year old and for which no solution have been reported. However, some of these concerns may have been resolved without the Committee being aware of these developments.
