## IGAD BRIEF UPDATE REPORT TO THE SPS COMMITTEE MARCH 2023

## COMMUNICATION FROM THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITY ON DEVELOPMENT (IGAD)

The following communication, received on 24 February 2023, is being circulated at the request of the <u>Intergovernmental Authority on Development</u> (IGAD).

- 1. The IGAD Center for Pastoral Areas and Livestock Development (ICPALD) is a regional technical center of IGAD (Intergovernmental Authority on Development), a regional economic community serving the seven member States in East Africa (Djibouti, Ethiopia, Kenya, Sudan, South Sudan, Somalia and Uganda).
- 2. Technical support provided for the above member States by IGAD/ICPALD during the reporting period to enhance transboundary animal disease control and livestock trade in the region, complementing the national development efforts of member States, includes:

- 3. IGAD/ICPALD organized a three-day regional meeting (16-18 January 2023 in Ethiopia) to review the status of regional and national SPS committees; share good practices as well as get updates regarding IGAD member States' compliance status on matters of SPS measures. The meeting received presentations from IGAD/ICPALD, member States, WTO/SPS Secretariat; AfCFTA secretariat and WOAH.
- 4. The key recommendations are: Enhance coordination mechanisms with SPS dealing institutions and harmonization of SPS measures and standards with the regional and international requirements; Develop the capacity of the actors along the value chain including the private sector; enhance reporting mechanisms/communication dissemination; advocate for the harmonization of halal standards and certification among importing GCC countries to minimize hassle for exporters; study the economic loss incurred in the region due to lack of SPS compliance to use as evidence, and strengthen national SPS committees and facilitate their participation in AfCFTA sub-committee.
