## IGAD BRIEF UPDATE REPORT TO THE SPS COMMITTEE JULY 2023

## COMMUNICATION FROM THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITY ON DEVELOPMENT (IGAD)

The following communication, received on 15 June 2023, is being circulated at the request of the <u>Intergovernmental Authority on Development</u> (IGAD).

- 1. The IGAD Center for Pastoral Areas and Livestock Development (ICPALD) is a regional technical center of IGAD (Intergovernmental Authority on Development), a regional economic community serving the eight member States in East Africa (Djibouti, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Kenya, Sudan, South Sudan, Somalia and Uganda).
- 2. Technical support provided for the above member States by IGAD/ICPALD during the reporting period to enhance transboundary animal disease control and livestock trade in the region, complementing the national development efforts of member States includes:

## 1 CONTROL AND ERADICATION OF PPR (PESTE DES PETITS RUMINANTS)

- 3. IGAD/ICPALD organized the  $10^{th}$  regional PPR control and eradication coordination meeting from 3-5 May 2023 to share updates on the progress of the regional and national PPR control and eradication program implementation; good practices; lessons; and agree on the next steps to help the region contribute to the global PPR eradication plan.
- 4. The key recommendations were: IGAD and member States to facilitate the operationalization of signed cross border bilateral and multilateral MOUs following the episystem approaches; facilitate harmonized cross-border PPR surveillance and vaccination to achieve disease eradication; support regional training on surveillance, risk analysis, diagnostics, and wildlife surveillance; facilitate further socio-economic study and disseminate findings for further advocacy and increased funding for eradication; and undertake resource mobilization to support cross-border transboundary disease control programs, among others.
