ANNUAL REPORT ON THE USE OF THE PROCEDURE TO ENCOURAGE AND FACILITATE THE RESOLUTION OF SPECIFIC SANITARY OR PHYTOSANITARY ISSUES AMONG MEMBERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 12.2 (G/SPS/61)

## 1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. The "Procedure to encourage and facilitate the resolution of specific sanitary or phytosanitary issues among Members in accordance with Article 12.2" in document  $\underline{G/SPS/61}$  (the *ad hoc* consultations procedure) was adopted by the Committee on 9 July 2014. This decision requires the Secretariat to report once a year on the use of the procedure.
- 1.2. This report covers the period from 1 October 2022 until 30 September 2023. During this time-period, one Member requested consultations under the *ad hoc* consultations procedure.

## **2 NEW REQUESTS**

- 2.1. On 6 October 2022, Brazil requested the Good Offices of the Chair under Article 12.2 of the SPS Agreement and the *ad hoc* consultations procedure regarding issues pertaining to the export of swine meat to Mexico, related to three previously discussed specific trade concerns (STCs) (STC ID 263, STC ID 271, and STC ID 489²). On 27 October 2022, Mexico provided a response in accordance with paragraph 2.3 of the *ad hoc* consultations procedure. Mexico rejected the request because it had published the requirements to be met for the importation of pork from Brazil to Mexico and thus was of the view that it was not necessary to continue with the Good Offices of the Chair.
- 2.2. In accordance with paragraphs 2.2 and 2.5 of the *ad hoc* consultations procedure, Brazil's request and Mexico's response to the request were circulated on the same day, on 8 November 2022, in documents <u>G/SPS/GEN/2078</u> and <u>G/SPS/GEN/2079</u>.
- 2.3. Furthermore, in accordance with paragraph 2.6 of the *ad hoc* consultations procedure, at the November 2022 Committee meeting, the Chair informed the Committee of this request for consultations and the corresponding answer to that request.<sup>3</sup>
