Communication from Paraguay

1. At its 69th annual General Session, held in Paris from 27 May to 1 June 2001, the International Committee of the Office international des Epizooties (OIE) adopted resolutions on the status of a number of Member countries in regard to foot-and-mouth disease.

2. By Resolution No. XVII, the International Committee recognized Paraguay as a Member country free from foot-and-mouth disease with vaccination, in accordance with Chapter 2.1.1 of the International Animal Health Code.
