### UNOFFICIAL TRANSLATIONS

#### Note by the Secretariat<sup>1</sup>

1. As indicated during the meeting of the SPS Committee in March 2004, the Secretariat has established a mechanism to circulate information on the availability of unofficial translations of draft regulations notified by Members. This mechanism aims to address a concern raised by Members regarding the difficulties they face in translating proposed regulations of other Members into a language in which they can work.
2. While notifications to the WTO are available in the three official languages, the actual texts of the proposed measures are not necessarily available in any language other than that (those) officially used in the notifying Member. This may lead to delays and difficulties for other Members to comprehend and provide comments in time on proposed measures. At the same time, a number of Members prepare unofficial translations of other Members' proposed measures for their own use. These are often available for consultation on an Internet site.
3. The new mechanism set up by the WTO Secretariat aims to facilitate information-sharing by Members on the availability of such unofficial translations on the Internet. This will be done via the circulation of a supplement (in the three official languages of the WTO) to the original notification submitted by a Member. The format of the supplement is attached.
4. Neither the Secretariat nor the Member providing the unofficial translation can be held responsible for the accuracy or quality of these translations.
