Addendum

The following communication, received on 22 May 2007, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Brazil.

- 1. The Secretariat of Animal and Plant Health of the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Food Supply (SDA/MAPA) issued Normative Instruction N° 13 on 25 April 2007, which was published in the "Diário Oficial da União" (Federal Official Journal) N° 81, on 27 April 2007, to revalidate, for an one-year period, the recognition as an area free of the pest *Anastrepha grandis*, the area concerning seven counties of Ceará State, as follows: Aracati, Itaiçaba, Jaguaruana, Icapuí, Russas, Quixeré and Limoeiro do Norte. The recognition of the area in question was previously notified in document G/SPS/GEN/562 on 31 March 2005.
