TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO DEVELOPING COUNTRIES PROVIDED BY AUSTRALIA JULY 2013 – JUNE 2015

COMMUNICATION FROM AUSTRALIA

Addendum

The following communication, received on 29 August 2016, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Australia</u>.

1. In response to the Secretariat's request in G/SPS/W/101, Australia submits the attached list of technical assistance provided to developing countries between 1 July 2013 and 30 June 2015, in accordance with Article 9 of the Agreement on the Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures (SPS Agreement). The list is not an exhaustive compilation of all technical assistance provided.

2. The aggregate value of the official development technical assistance provided between July 2013 and June 2015, as listed in the appended table, exceeded A\$35 million. In many cases Australia also provides substantial additional in-kind contributions.

3. Technical assistance is primarily aimed at helping developing countries to adjust to, and comply with, SPS measures in their export markets and to improve their capacity in developing and implementing their own SPS measures based on science and international standards. For the reporting period assistance was provided through 45 projects and given to a total of 56 individual Members, Observers or non-Member countries, mainly in the Asia-Pacific region, but also in Africa and the Middle East. Assistance was directed to individual countries as well as to groups of countries or regional organisations such as Pacific Island Forum countries, Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) forum and the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN).
