The following paragraphs were accidentally omitted from the summary report of the Twenty-Fourth Meeting of the Committee on Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures held on 25-26 June 2002. They should be inserted after paragraph 130 under Other Business.

Cuba: EC pesticide and antibiotic limits in honey (Directive 96/23)

130.(bis) The representative of Cuba informed the Committee about bilateral consultations on pesticide residues in honey with the European Communities to allow Cuba to maintain or increase its access to the EC market. Cuba would provide an update of the progress resulting from these consultations at the November Committee meeting.

130.(ter) The representative of the European Communities confirmed that Cuba had submitted a plan for residue analysis which the European Communities was examining. The European Communities agreed to inform Cuba of the results of this examination and to engage in further bilateral consultations.
