## QUESTIONNAIRE ON THE OPERATION OF SPS ENQUIRY POINTS AND NATIONAL NOTIFICATION AUTHORITIES

- 1. Pursuant to Article 14 of the Agreement on the Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures "[t]he least-developed country Members may delay application of the provisions of this Agreement for a period of five years following the date of entry into force of the WTO Agreement with respect to their sanitary or phytosanitary measures affecting importation or imported products". This period ends on 31 December 1999. Following the expiry of this transition period, the least-developed countries are, *inter alia*, subject to the obligations to establish an Enquiry Point, as provided for in paragraphs 3 and 4 of Annex B of the SPS Agreement; and a National Notification Authority responsible for the implementation, at the national level, of the provisions concerning notification procedures according to paragraphs 5, 6, 7 and 8 of Annex B.
- 2. The purpose of this questionnaire is to collect information from Members on the operation of their Enquiry Points and National Notification Authorities. Drawing on Members' experience the Secretariat then intends to develop a manual to assist least-developed countries in the establishment of Enquiry Points and National Notification Authorities.
- 3. Members are therefore requested to fill in the attached questionnaire. Any additional information relevant to the matter at issue is also welcome.
