³ Registered users can receive daily or weekly customized email alerts on SPS/TBT notifications, based on products and markets of interest. They can also save filters and identify favourite notifications for easier follow up.

⁴ The outreach admins can access a list of all domestic registered users, create groups, and reach out to them via ePing.

⁵ The outreach admins can access a list of all other registered users with outreach admin rights and start private conversations with a group of them.

⁶ The notification admins can update contact details of their Enquiry Points and Notification Authorities directly on the platform.

⁷ Outreach and notification admin rights are managed by the WTO Secretariat and granted upon request, mainly to officials from Enquiry Points and Notification Authorities. SPS rights are independent from TBT rights, but not mutually exclusive.

⁸ Notification admins can grant notification drafting or submission rights to other domestic registered users.
