Draft Decision of the DSB

The DSB agrees that, upon a request by the Republic of Indonesia or the United States of America, the DSB shall no later than January 20, 2012 adopt the report of the panel in the dispute *United States – Measures Affecting the Production and Sale of Clove Cigarettes* (WT/DS406) unless (i) the DSB decides by consensus not to do so or (ii) either party to the dispute notifies the DSB of its decision to appeal pursuant to Article 16.4 of the *Understanding on Rules and Procedures Governing the Settlement of Disputes*.
